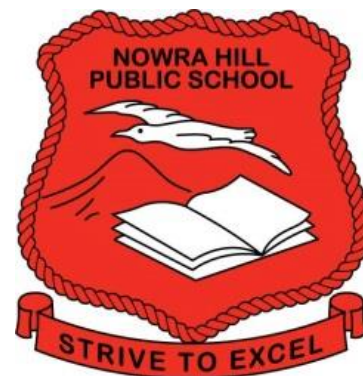

### **FIRST AID IN SCHOOLS PROGRAM**

During Mondays of weeks 9 & 10 Stage 2 & 3 children will participate in the St Johns First Aid in Schools Program. This is a free program and it provides students with first aid skills they can use in the event of an emergency.

The program will be delivered by Mr Vucic with the support of the St Johns (NSW) E Learning Plus module. Stage 3 (Year 5 & 6) students will be instructed in the DRASAB action plan, calling an ambulance, recovery position, burns, managing bleeding and bandaging. The Stage 3 students will have their session on Monday morning of week 9.

Stage 2 will have a similar program, but without the bandaging, on Monday morning of week 10.

It is recommended that girls wear culottes or sports tights as they will be asked to put each other in the recovery position to practise this manoeuvre.
