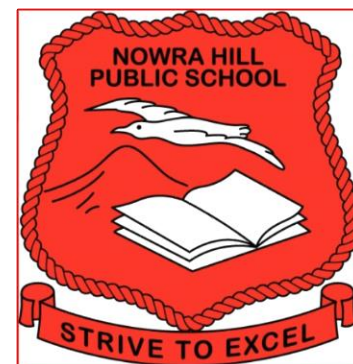

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to week three of term two. A busy week this week, with our Year 5 and Year 3 students sitting NAPLAN. I must compliment the students in these year groups for the mature and settled manner in which they have approached the test, well done!

Gymnastics has been a hit with our students this term. Please make sure you are completing the eForm on the NHPS App and submitting your payment as soon as possible. The gymnastics program is one that delivers part of our PDHPE syllabus and supplements and enhances our physical activity and sporting programs.

Next week sees the Life Education Van visiting our school. All classes will be taking part in sessions appropriate for their year level, that focus on Body Matters, Friendship Development, Safety Rules, Cyber wise, and/or Making Good Choices. Parents are asked to complete the note on the bottom of this bulletin or visit our App to complete the eForm.

At the end of this term, parents will be receiving progress reports that will provide you with an indication of where your child is at in relation to their achievement of learning outcomes at school. We will also be providing parents with a copy of the Feedback To Parents report that is generated from the PLAN software. This report lets parents know where their child is at in relation to the Literacy and Numeracy continuums, and provides parents with advice on how they can support their child's learning at home.

I really do need to ask for parent and community support in relation to the carpark and pick up and drop off at the front of the school. As I have mentioned earlier, **Council will be installing and monitoring No Stopping areas** along the driveway and a **Kiss and Drop zone** in front of the school fence. They will also be installing barriers along the footpath to prevent cars from driving over the designated safe area for our children to walk. We will also continue communicating and planning a long term solution for a safer carpark area.

I continue to ask for your support as parents and carers by:

- Driving at an appropriate speed
- No longer using the reverse parking area, this is now the Kiss and Drop zone, so cars should pull up parallel with the school fence in that zone
- NOT parking alongside the footpath
- NOT parking in front of the school – Kiss and Drop only
- Using the grassed triangle as a roundabout
- NOT parking on the upper grassed triangle
- NOT calling children out into the carpark unattended, or calling them to jump over the fence
- NOT walking through the staff access gate and driveway; having pedestrians walk through the staff gate and up the driveway has caused significant issues for staff.

It is vitally important that parents follow these recommendations, we want all our kids to arrive at and leave school safely!
