The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for pedestrians and vehicles outside schools. **Parking signs** are planned with your child's safety in mind.

It is helpful for everyone if you park safely, even if you have to walk further to the school gate. This is a good time to model positive road safety behaviour and physical activity for your child.

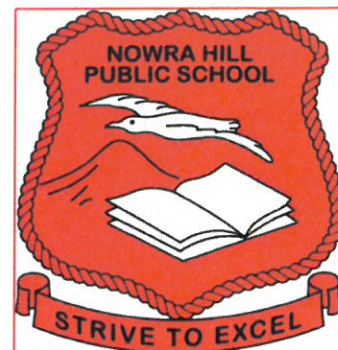
Drop your child off and pick them up on the school side of the road. Calling out to them from across the road is dangerous – they may run to you without checking for traffic. This will help keep all children as safe as possible during the busiest times of the school day.

Dangerous driving behaviour around schools puts children at risk.

Model safe and considerate behaviour for your child – they will learn from you.

Thank you to those parents who have been taking extra care in the **carpark area and are now parallel parking while dropping their children of in the Kiss and Drop Zone**. We ask for your continued support in this area by:

- **Not parking over or near the footpath leading down to the bus stop**
 - Using the parking directly in front of the school fence as a parallel "Kiss and Drop" zone only
 - **Parking on the grassed area only if parking and leaving car**
 - Using the grass triangle as a pseudo-roundabout
 - No foot traffic through the bottom staff carpark gate

Safety tips

Safety tips for drivers using a Drop-off and Pick-up zones

- Always drop off or pick up your child from the designated zone and follow the school's procedures.
- Drivers should remain in their vehicles at all times in the Drop-off and Pick-up zone.
- Make sure children use the Safety Door (the rear footpath side door) to get in and out of the car.
- Make sure the handbrake is applied when the vehicle is stationary.
- Always park legally.
- Avoid dangerous manoeuvres such as U-turns and three-point turns.

Safety tips for students

- Always get in and out of the vehicle through the Safety Door, the rear footpath-side door.
- Stay buckled up until the vehicle has stopped in the Drop-off and pick-up area.
- Make sure your school bag and other items are in a safe position, such as on the floor.
- Be ready to get out of the vehicle with your belongings when the car has stopped and you have unbuckled your seatbelt.

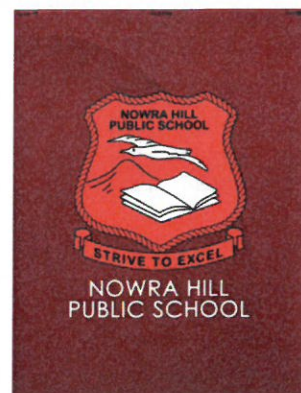

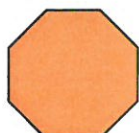
