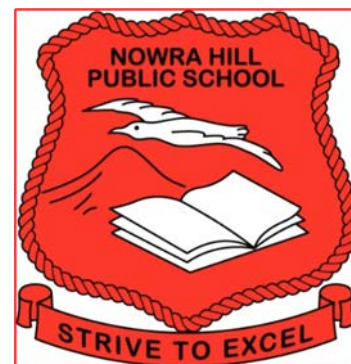
## Nowra Hill Public School
