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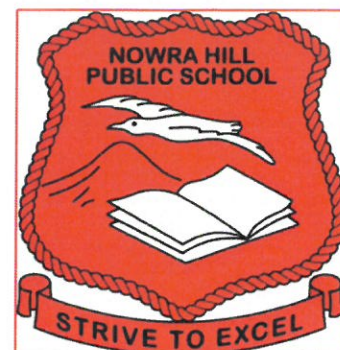
Dear Parents/Carers,

FISST (SMALL SCHOOLS) ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

Last term, it was announced that Greenwell Point PS had won the FISST Percentage Trophy for the Athletics Carnival on the Monday of Week 10. In perusing the results an anomaly was noticed where the Carnival Manager program had inadvertently reversed the results of several 100m races. Once the records were corrected it did affect several of the results. Nowra Hill are now the Percentage Trophy winners for 2017 and the trophy is already engraved and can be seen on top of the trophy cabinet in the school office.

Nowra Hill earned 1.75%, marginally ahead of Greenwell Point PS on 1.60% and Kangaroo Valley PS on 1.58%. A very close result. These corrected results also mean that we have joint Senior Boy Champions: Nicholas Iloski and Harrison MB both on 13 championship points. Congratulations also to Geena Viney and Matthew Higham who are division athletics champions for 2017.

The PSSA District Athletics Carnival will be held on Thursday, 10th August (half day Carnival for high jump and 1500m) and Friday, 11th August (full day Carnival for remaining events). Permission notes for our 26 District Athletics competitors will come out in the next few weeks. Transport will be by private vehicle.

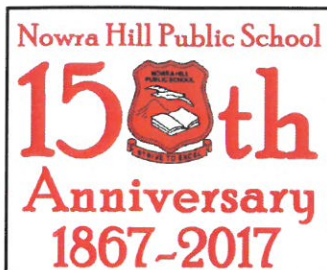
