The 2019 Nowra Hill PS Presentation Night will this year be held at Nowra High School from 6pm – 8pm on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> December. The decision to hold the event in the larger school hall of our local high school is due to the increase in student enrolments at NHPS over the last three years. Our school hall is literally too small for this important event.

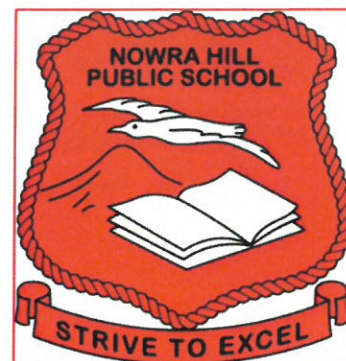
Last year's Presentation Night was held at the Fleet Air Arm Museum at Albatross base. While it was a successful venue, it also came with an equipment hire cost. This will not be the case at Nowra HS.

The increase in student numbers also brings a need for further changes with Presentation Night. These changes were discussed with staff members and the P&C before any decisions were made.

This year Presentation Night will be less performance-based and more of an acknowledgement of those students who have excelled in particular aspects of school life (including academic, social, citizenship, sporting and leadership). Previously, every student at the school received a book prize but this year it will only be award winners (5 per class as well as special awards) who receive either certificates, book prizes or vouchers.

Not all classes will be performing items. The school brass band will perform on the night and we are also planning a special item that will showcase all our wonderful students.

We are also separating Presentation Night and Year 6 Farewell celebrations. While we will still acknowledge our graduating Year 6 group, Miss Leslie is planning a separate farewell event and showcase for the outgoing Year 6 students.

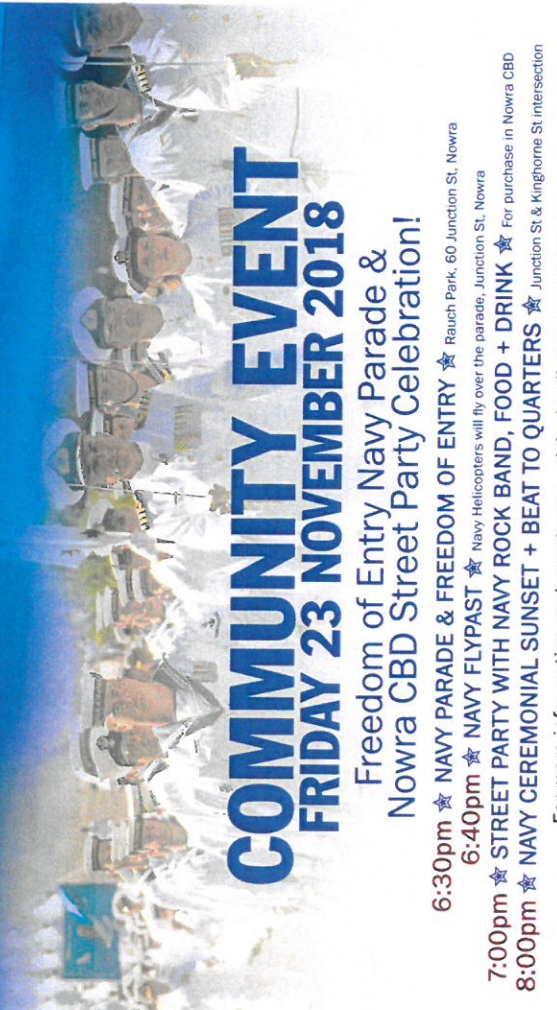
