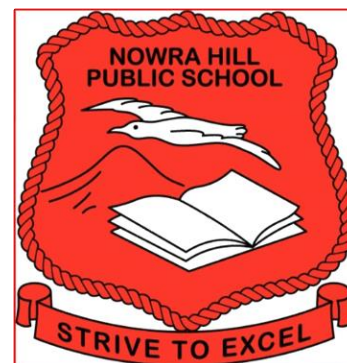
### Year 6 Graduation and Leadership Speech Assemblies

### Yr 6 FUNDRAIDER – LUNCHTIME ICEBLOCKS AND ICECREAMS

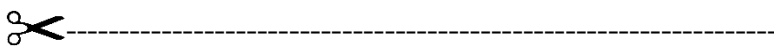
