Nowra Hill Public School

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

No need to let us know you have collected one, you can just pick one up. They will be there after school hours also.

Please be assured that the unit of work that is being sent home is exactly the same as the one being completed at school. The only difference being that parents are supervising the learning at home and teachers at school will supervise the learning here. No new learning will occur at school and therefore your child will not be disadvantaged by staying home.

Students return for Term 2

As a school we have decided to use the SEESAW app for communication between you, your child and their class teacher. For all other general inquiries about school you will need to phone the office and talk to either myself or Mrs Jones. Many parents will be familiar with SEESAW as some classes are using it this year or have done so in previous years. It is an easy app to use and we thought it would be very practical for our school. Teachers are able to send out group messages to their class as a whole or to individual students. Parents or students can message the teacher if they need anything clarified. It will also be used as a platform for you to take photos of your child's work and send to their teacher for feedback etc. Information regarding how to download the app and your child's username and password will also be in the tub outside the office at school. If you would prefer for us to just email you the SEESAW username and password then let us know. Please understand that this will not happen immediately if we need this to be done for all students. It will take some time and your patience is appreciated.

I would also like to clarify some rumours about staff staying home. Yes staff who fall into the high risk category will be working from home. They will still be available for you or your child to contact via SEESAW and they will be continuing to develop units of work for home study as well as planning and programming for Term 2. For their safety and the safety of others this was the recommendation from both the Departments of Health and Education.

Nowra Hill Public School has a strong community spirit which I am very privileged to be a part of. We all pulled together and supported each other through fires and flooding and I know we will get through the COVID-19 pandemic if we continue to stay positive, be supportive, look after ourselves and our families as well as look out for our neighbours. I ask parents to be mindful about what they are saying to and around their children at this time to minimise panic and stress for our children. Our children need to feel safe and supported at this time.
