

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

Welcome to Week 1 Term 3. Firstly, I'd like to begin by saying thank you to everyone including staff and community, for taking on board all the new and updated COVID regulations so quickly and positively. I hope you had an enjoyable holiday with your child/ren even though I'm sure you may have had to change plans and things looked a little bit different.

The following regulations, which have been guided by NSW Health, have been implemented across all Regional Areas (Schools outside the Greater Sydney) including Nowra Hill PS.

- Students should NOT attend school (even with mild symptoms) if unwell.
- Students should not return until they have received a negative test result (which needs to be emailed to the school) and are **symptom-free**.
- Non-essential visitors are not permitted in schools.
- Follow mask-wearing requirements and sign in using the Service NSW QR code when entering the school.
- Maintain physical distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
- Students and staff should reduce travelling to geographical areas with higher levels of COVID-19 restrictions in place.
- Changes to some school activities to include COVID safe practices are to be made.
