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Week 10 already. This term has been busy and has flown by.

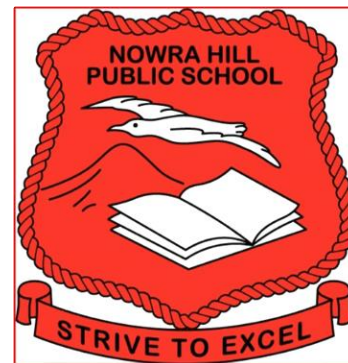
